Terms of Reference (TORs) to develop and publish a press release on the process, status and key issues for civil society on the wetlands policy and Bill

	Background
	Wetlands International (WI) and the Ecological Christian Organization (ECO) in collaboration with CARE International in Uganda are supporting the government of Uganda to review the National Wetlands Policy and its attendant draft Bill 2009.
Background	Particularly for the Bill, the process started way back before 2009 where a draft and Principles of the Bill were drafted. For the Policy, it was long overdue since 1995 when it was enacted and no review had been done since then, yet so many things had changed including emerging issues such as climate change and green growth that needed to be considered. In 2017, the Ministry of Water and Environment in collaboration with the Partners for Resilience (PfR), started the process of review of the policy and redrafting of the 2009 Bill.
	The process has achieved a number of milestones that include: production of a draft revised policy and Bill; and production of a Regulatory Impact Assessment. These culminated from a long process of country wide and multi-stakeholder consultations. As Partners for Resilience, it is good practice to document the process, its experiences, challenges and opportunities for sharing with external audiences.

	 Produce a standard press release document with a summary of key issues. These are in the context of Integrated Risk Management
